The **Ministry of Food and Agriculture** has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of **West Africa Food System Resilience Project (FSRP)** and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for “**Development of Selected Inland Valleys in the Ashanti Region – Lot 1: Anunuso Water Conservation Scheme**.”
2. The **Ministry of Food & Agriculture** acting through the **West Africa Food System Resilience Project (FSRP)**, now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the **Development of Selected Inland Valleys in the Ashanti Region – Lot 1: Anunuso Water Conservation Scheme**.

The objective of this assignment is to obtain the services of a contractor to rehabilitate or construct water conservation infrastructure at selected inland valleys in the Ashanti Region of Ghana as indicated in Table 1 below:

Bidders are to note that the work includes the construction of headworks required for water abstraction and conveyance systems for the supply and distribution of water. Additionally, Bidders will be responsible for the establishment of a network of roads, drainage systems, land development as well as the appurtenant structures required to operationalize the scheme.

Bidding will be conducted through national competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "[*Procurement in Investment Project Financing \(IPF\): Goods, Works, Non-Consulting and Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers*](#)" published in **February 2025, 6th Edition**, ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.

The bidding document in *English language* may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of *US\$100.00 or GHS1,500.00*. The method of payment will be by Cash to the West Africa Food System Resilience Program (FSRP). The document will be physically picked up at the address below.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **10:30 am on June 17, 2025**. Electronic bidding will **not** be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend, at the address below on **June 17, 2025, at 10:30 am at the FSRP Conference Room**.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a ***Bid Security (Unconditional Bid Guarantee or Bid Bond)*** in the amounts indicated in **Table 1** above.
8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
